1. Introduction

The AAL JP is a funding activity that aims to create better condition of life for the older adults and to strengthen the industrial opportunities in Europe through the use of information and communication technology (ICT). It carries out its mandate through the funding of across-national projects (at least three countries involved) that involves small and medium enterprises (SME), research bodies and user's organizations (representing the older adults).

The programme is financed by the European Commission and the 22 countries that constitute the Partner States of this Joint Programme:

Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

The overall budget is of € 600 Mil to co-finance Research & Development & Innovation projects aiming to deliver concrete solutions for independent living or 'ageing well' of elderly people using ICT. This funding activity is implemented by the AAL Association and the funding authorities of its member countries.

This report presents consolidated statistics regarding submitted and ranked proposals in response to the six calls under the AAL Joint Programme.

Note: The proposals which constitute the ranking list were evaluated by independent experts. The ranking list does not yet list the proposals that will receive funding from this call. Funding budgets under the AAL Joint Programme are reserved for organisations residing in the country that committed the funding, and thus, the outcome of the evaluation process does – very likely – not match the available national budgets in an optimal way.

On the basis of the ranking list a budget optimisation process is conducted that reflects the availability or scarcity of national funding budgets. This process will lead to changes in the composition of the consortia of ranked proposals. At the end of this process, a funding list is compiled which is the list of proposals with whom the negotiations will be started if the AAL General Assembly approves the list.






Charts 1: Partners in submitted proposals









Charts 2: Coordinators in submitted proposals




Charts 4: No. of organisations in ranked proposals per country









Charts 5: Number of coordinators in ranked proposals per country





Charts 6: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Austria












Charts 7: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Belgium









Charts 8: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Cyprus









Charts 9: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Denmark









Charts 10: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Finland









Charts 11: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for France



















Charts 13: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Greece









Charts 14: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Hungary



















Charts 16: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Israel









Charts 17: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Italy









Charts 18: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Luxembourg









Charts 19: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for the Netherlands








Charts 20: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Norway







Charts 21: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Poland









Charts 22: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Portugal









Charts 23: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Romania









Charts 24: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Slovenia









Charts 25: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Spain









Charts 26: Number of submitted and ranked proposals for Sweden


