1. Call AAL-2010-3

This report presents statistics regarding submitted and ranked proposals in response to the third call under the AAL Joint Programme entitled "ICT-based Solutions for Advancement of Older Persons' Independence and Participation in the "Self-Serve Society"

The call deadline was on 30 July 2010 with an indicative total funding of 54.60 Mio € that was committed by 23 national funding authorities from 21 AAL Partner States and the European Commission.

A total 91 proposals were eligible for the evaluation in this call and 30 of them constitute the ranking list, i.e. these were positively evaluated by independent experts. The ranking list does not yet list the proposals that will receive funding from this call. Funding budgets under the AAL Joint Programme are reserved for organisations residing in the country that committed the funding, and thus, the outcome of the evaluation process does – very likely – not match the available national budgets in an optimal way.

On the basis of the ranking list a budget optimisation process is conducted that reflects the availability or scarcity of national funding budgets. This process will lead to changes in the composition of the consortia of ranked proposals. At the end of this process, a funding list is compiled which is the list of proposals with whom the negotiations will be started if the AAL General Assembly approves the list.


2. Submitted proposals









Project partners in submitted proposals (N=680)

Requested funding in % in submitted proposals



Organisation types in submitted proposals (N=680)







Chart 5: Organisation types in submitted proposals (N= 680)






Charts 6 + 7: No. or organisations and coordinators in ranked proposals per country


No. of organisations (N=234) in ranked proposals

No. of coordinators (N=30) in ranked proposals






Charts 8 +9: Budget figures in ranked proposals per country

Average raquested funding from partners in ranked proposals













Organisation types in ranked proposals (N=234)
