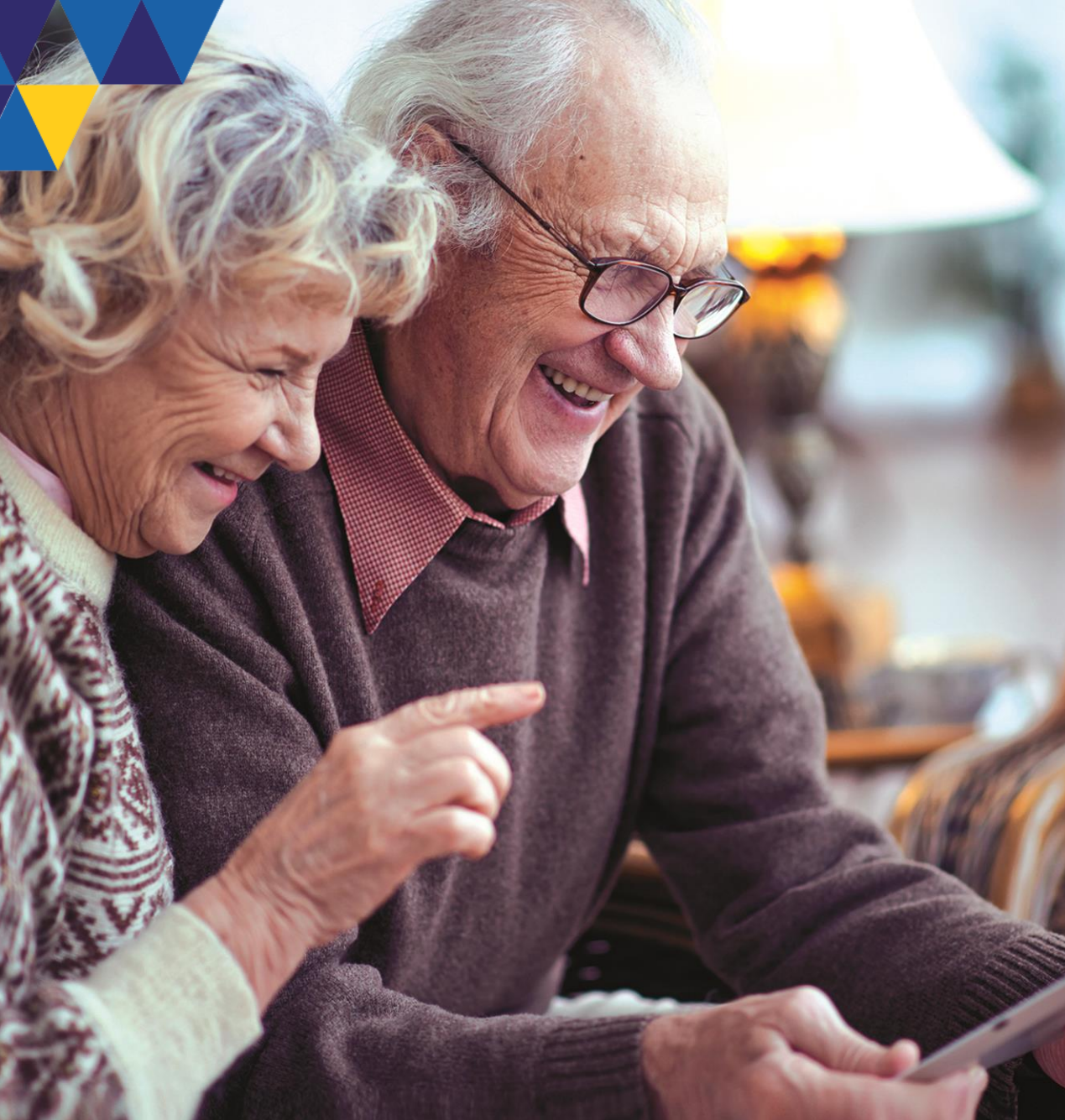

WHY NL PARTICIPATES IN AAL PROGRAMME*

- To get **AAL-solutions available on the NL market** for use by older adults and their social/support networks - informal and professional
- **Involving NL end users** in co-creation and testing/evaluating the solutions
- **Creating broad commitment** and interest in ICT innovations by primary, secondary and tertiary end user organisations throughout the country

NL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

- **1 NL user organisation as potential ‘launching customer’**
 - . Participates in pilots/field trials – considerable number of users
 - . NL user organisation in only 1 funded collaborative project
- **1 company ACTIVE on NL market**
 - . Serving NL market / supporting NL users/organisations - also after the project!
- **Max. budget €500.000 per project for NL partners in 1 project**

NL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

SMALL COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

- Involvement of NL users (organisation, as partner / via subcontracting)
- Max. NL budget €100.000 per project

FUNDING RATES NL

TYPE OF ORGANISATION	MAX. FUNDING RATE
Primary end user organisations (senior organisations etc.)	75%
Secondary end user organisations (careg/welfare organisations etc.)	65%
Tertiairy end user organisations (municipal, provincial dpts.)	50%
Other organisations (R&D, universities/applied sciences, expertcentres etc.)	70%
SME – small	60%
SME - medium	50%
Large enterprises	40%
